Parent Take-Home Sheet

WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the story of Daniel in the Lion's Den from Daniel 6. We talked about how Daniel trusted God and kept praying even when it was against the law. The big idea: God protects those who trust Him.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"My God sent his angel, and he shut the mouths of the lions." (Daniel 6:22)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to tell you the story. Why was Daniel thrown into the den? How did God save him?
- Talk about peer pressure: When is it hard to stand up for what is right?
- Daniel prayed three times a day. What helps you remember to pray?
- Pray together: Thank God for His protection. Ask Him for courage to stand firm in faith.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Daniel 6 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Set up regular prayer times together as a family.
- Talk about other people in the Bible who stood firm (Shadrach, Meshach, Abednego).
