

# DAVID'S SLINGSHOT CRAFT

*A hands-on reminder that God is bigger than any giant*

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- Y-shaped twig or craft sticks (2 sticks + 1 base)
- Rubber band or thick yarn
- Small felt or fabric pouch (2 inch square)
- 5 small pom-poms or crumpled paper balls (the stones)
- Tape or hot glue (adult help needed)
- Markers or crayons for decorating

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Form the Y-shape: If using craft sticks, tape or glue two sticks together at an angle to form a V. Attach a third stick as the handle.
2. Attach the band: Tie or tape the rubber band (or yarn) between the two tips of the Y. Leave some slack in the middle.
3. Add the pouch: Tape or glue the small fabric pouch to the center of the rubber band. This is where David would have placed his stone.
4. Decorate: Use markers to write the memory verse on the handle, or decorate with patterns.
5. Make the stones: Roll 5 small paper balls or use pom-poms. These represent the five smooth stones David chose from the stream.
6. Practice: Hold the handle, place a pom-pom in the pouch, pull back gently, and release toward a safe target (never at people).

## WHILE YOU CRAFT, ASK:

- Why did David choose five stones instead of just one?
- What giant problems are you facing this week?
- How can we remember to trust God like David did?
