

# JESUS FEEDS THE 5000

## *Parent Take-Home Sheet*

### **WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY**

Today your child heard the story of Jesus feeding the 5,000 from John 6:1-14. We talked about how a boy shared his small lunch and Jesus turned it into a feast for thousands. The big idea: When we give what we have to Jesus, He can do more than we imagine.

### **THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE**

*"Here is a boy with five small barley loaves and two small fish." (John 6:9)*

### **TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME**

- Ask your child to retell the story. How much food did the boy have? How many people were fed?
- Talk about generosity: What do you have that you could share?
- Why do you think Jesus asked the boy to share instead of making food appear from nothing?
- Pray together: Thank Jesus for multiplying what we give. Ask Him to use your gifts.

### **DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK**

- Read John 6:1-14 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Make a snack together and share it with neighbors.
- Talk about other miracles Jesus did and what they teach us about Him.
