

JONAH IN THE FISH CRAFT

A fun reminder that God gives second chances

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Blue paper plate
- White and blue paper
- Small Jonah figure (paper cutout or small plastic person)
- Brass fastener
- Scissors, glue, markers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the paper plate in half to make the fish body.
2. Cut a triangle tail from blue paper and glue to one end.
3. Cut a fish mouth opening on the other end.
4. Draw fins and an eye on the fish.
5. Attach the two halves with a brass fastener so the mouth opens.
6. Place the Jonah figure inside so he peeks out when the mouth opens.

WHILE YOU CRAFT, ASK:

- What did Jonah do inside the fish?
- How does God give you second chances?
- What should we do when God asks us to do something hard?
