

PARTING THE SEA CRAFT

A hands-on reminder that God makes a way

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Blue construction paper (2 sheets per child)
- Tan or brown paper for the path
- Brass fastener (1 per child)
- Small people figures or paper cutouts
- Glue, scissors, markers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut a tan paper strip for the dry path through the sea.
2. Cut each blue paper sheet into a wave shape along one side.
3. Attach both blue papers to the tan paper with a brass fastener at the top center.
4. The blue papers should be able to open and close over the path.
5. Draw or glue small people walking through the parted sea.
6. Write Exodus 14:14 on the tan path.

WHILE YOU CRAFT, ASK:

- What impossible situations is God able to handle?
- Why did God tell the people to be still?
- How can we remember that God fights for us?
