Parent Take-Home Sheet

WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the story of Moses parting the Red Sea from Exodus 14. We talked about how God rescued His people when they were trapped and afraid. The big idea: God makes a way when we see no way out.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still." (Exodus 14:14)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to retell the story. What happened when Moses stretched out his staff?
- Talk about times when you felt stuck. How did God help?
- Why is it sometimes hard to 'be still' and trust God?
- Pray together: Thank God that nothing is impossible for Him. Ask Him for faith when you feel stuck.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Exodus 14 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Act out the story together. Use a blue blanket for the sea!
- Talk about other times God made a way (crossing the Jordan, etc.).
