

RAINBOW PROMISE CRAFT

A colorful reminder that God keeps His promises

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Paper plate (1 per child)
- Cotton balls (3-4 per child)
- Crayons or markers in rainbow colors
- Glue stick
- Scissors
- Optional: glitter glue

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the paper plate in half. This will be your rainbow base.
2. Draw rainbow arcs on the plate: red, orange, yellow, green, blue, purple (from outer edge to inner curve).
3. Color each arc with the matching color, pressing firmly for bright colors.
4. Glue cotton balls along the flat edge of the plate to make clouds.
5. Write the memory verse reference (Genesis 9:13) on the back.
6. Optional: Add glitter glue along the arcs for extra sparkle.

WHILE YOU CRAFT, ASK:

- What does the rainbow mean in the Bible?
- Can you name a promise God has made to you?
- How does it feel to know God keeps every promise?
