Parent Take-Home Sheet

WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the story of Noah's Ark from Genesis 6-9. We talked about how Noah trusted and obeyed God even when everyone around him thought he was crazy. The big idea: God keeps His promises. The rainbow is a sign of God's faithfulness.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"I have set my rainbow in the clouds, and it will be the sign of the covenant between me and the earth." (Genesis 9:13)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to tell you the story. How long did it rain? What did the rainbow mean?
- Talk about waiting: What is something you are waiting for right now? How can we trust God while we wait?
- Noah obeyed God even when it was hard and people made fun of him. When is it hard to obey God?
- Pray together: Thank God for His promises. Ask Him to help you trust and obey even when it is hard.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Genesis 9:8-17 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day. Point to rainbows when you see them.
- Draw a rainbow together and write a promise from the Bible on it.
- Talk about other covenants (promises) God made in the Bible.
