Parent Take-Home Sheet

WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the parable of the Good Samaritan from Luke 10:25-37. We talked about how Jesus teaches us that our neighbor is anyone who needs help, even people who are different from us. The big idea: Love your neighbor as yourself.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"Love your neighbor as yourself." (Luke 10:27)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to retell the parable. Who helped the hurt man?
- Talk about differences: Why is it sometimes hard to help people who are not like us?
- Brainstorm together: Who needs help in our community?
- Pray together: Ask God to show you who your neighbor is this week.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Luke 10:25-37 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Do one act of kindness together this week for someone in need.
- Talk about how showing love to others is showing love to God.
