WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child explored Psalm 23 and John 10, learning that Jesus calls Himself the Good Shepherd. We talked about how Jesus knows us by name, leads us, and protects us. The big idea: We can trust Jesus to care for us like a shepherd cares for his sheep.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want." (Psalm 23:1)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child: What does a shepherd do? Why does Jesus call Himself the Good Shepherd?
- Talk about trust: When is it hard to follow someone? How do we learn to trust Jesus?
- Psalm 23 says, 'I shall not want.' What does that mean?
- Pray together: Thank Jesus for being your Shepherd. Ask Him to lead you today.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Psalm 23 together as a family. It is short and beautiful!
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Listen to a song version of Psalm 23.
- Talk about other places in the Bible where Jesus is called a shepherd.
