WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the parable of the Prodigal Son from Luke 15:11-32. We talked about how a son ran away, wasted everything, but was welcomed home with open arms. The big idea: God loves us and welcomes us home no matter what we have done.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"While he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion." (Luke 15:20)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to retell the parable. What happened to the son? How did the father respond?
- Talk about forgiveness: Have you ever had to say sorry for something big?
- The father ran to his son. What does that tell us about how God feels about us?
- Pray together: Thank God for His forgiveness. Ask Him to help us forgive others.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Luke 15:11-32 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Have a 'welcome home' celebration for no reason. Celebrate being a family.
- Talk about the older brother in the story. What can we learn from him?
