

ZACCHAEUS IN THE TREE

A craft to remember that Jesus sees us

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Brown construction paper (for tree trunk)
- Green paper (for leaves)
- Small figure or paper cutout of Zacchaeus
- Cardstock or paper plate base
- Scissors, glue, markers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut a tree trunk shape from brown paper and glue to the base.
2. Cut leaf shapes or crumple green paper for the tree top.
3. Glue leaves to the top of the trunk.
4. Draw or cut out a small Zacchaeus figure.
5. Glue Zacchaeus peeking out from the leaves.
6. Write 'Jesus sees me!' on the base and add Luke 19:10.

WHILE YOU CRAFT, ASK:

- How did Jesus know Zacchaeus's name?
- Does Jesus see you no matter where you are?
- What changed when Zacchaeus met Jesus?
