WHAT WE LEARNED TODAY

Today your child heard the story of Zacchaeus from Luke 19:1-10. We talked about how Jesus saw a dishonest man everyone hated and completely changed his life. The big idea: Jesus sees us and loves us right where we are.

THIS WEEK'S MEMORY VERSE

"For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." (Luke 19:10)

TALK ABOUT IT AT HOME

- Ask your child to retell the story. What was Zacchaeus's job? Why did he climb the tree?
- Talk about change: What changed in Zacchaeus after meeting Jesus?
- Jesus knew Zacchaeus by name. Does it feel different knowing Jesus knows YOUR name?
- Pray together: Thank Jesus for seeing us. Ask Him to change our hearts like He changed Zacchaeus.

DO TOGETHER THIS WEEK

- Read Luke 19:1-10 together as a family.
- Practice the memory verse each day.
- Sing the 'Zacchaeus was a wee little man' song together.
- Talk about what it means that Jesus came 'to seek and save the lost.'
